

Fly on the Wall

Fly's head is abuzz. He's had endless difficulties reading Dr Seuss and his tongue-twisters to the six-year-old and the three-year-old. It's difficult to get it all straight. As Mr Knox said to Mr Fox, "Sir, my tongue is not made of rubber." Here goes.

The top judge told his fellow top judges that what another judge was said by two top judges to have said to those judges, about judging what another judge judged the President to have judged the deputy President to have done, was something a judge should not do. This when that other judge judged that this was not something the President should have judged, but something those who judge whether to bring the Deputy President before a judge should have judged.

So the top judges together judged that the people who judge who may be judges should judge whether this judge told the judges how to judge.

The top judges judged too that their judging, that the judge should not have told the judges how to judge, and that this should be judged by those who judge who should be judges, should first be made known to all, for them also to be the judge.

Meanwhile, many judged that the judge who judged that the President, rather than those who should judge, should not have judged whether to bring the Deputy President before a judge, was not called upon to judge, and should instead merely have judged whether, in judging to bring the Deputy President before a judge, this being a judging again of a judging whether to do so before, they should have asked him how he judged whether they should bring him before a judge. The President, who was judged best not to be President, has now asked other judges to judge, that the judge that judged that the President (judged best not to be President) should not have judged whether to bring the Deputy President (judged best not to be Deputy President) before a judge, should not have judged.

Some judge that such judges should judge that the President, who was judged best not to be President, should not have judged himself able to ask them to judge on what the judge judged, given that what the judge judged did not judge what the President, judged best not to be President, could have these judges judge.
